16 The Federation shall affiliate with the American Federation of Teachers, the California

## 21 Article IV Purpose

22 The purpose of this organization shall be to advance the status of teachers and other

6.The elected officers of the Executive Board shall have the authority to appoint and remove non-elected, voting or non-voting members to the Executive Board or grant or remove observer status to chairs or designees of selected standing or ad-hoc committees with a 2/3 majority vote. The term shall not exceed that of the current Executive Board.

7.Recall of officers shall be accomplished by a majority of votes cast by the entire membership. The recall election may be instigated by petition of twenty percent (20%) of the total membership, and shall be conducted by procedures determined by the Representative Council.

- 121 Article VII Elections

A. All officers and representatives shall be elected by a secret ballot election. All nominations
 shall be submitted at a general membership meeting in April or May. The ballots shall be
 distributed to all members no later than May 20th. All nominations and elections shall be
 conducted according to the Landrum-Griffin Act, other applicable federal and state laws, as
 well as any applicable portions of the constitutions, by-laws, and officially adopted written
 policies of the AFT, CFT or ABCFT.

B. Members in good standing are eligible to vote in elections if they were members in good
standing two (2) months before the date of the election.

# 133 Article VIII Amendments

A. Amendments to this Constitution may be proposed by 2/3 of the votes cast at a regular
 meeting of the Representative Council, provided the proposed amendment was read at a
 previous meeting.

- B. Amendments may be proposed by petition to the Representative council by 15% of themembership.
- 142 C. Ratification of the proposed amendment shall be by 2/3 majority of all votes cast by the
- 143 membership in an election conducted for that purpose by the Representative Council.

- to all members and providing 2/3 of those members of the Representative Council present
- and voting, vote affirmatively.
